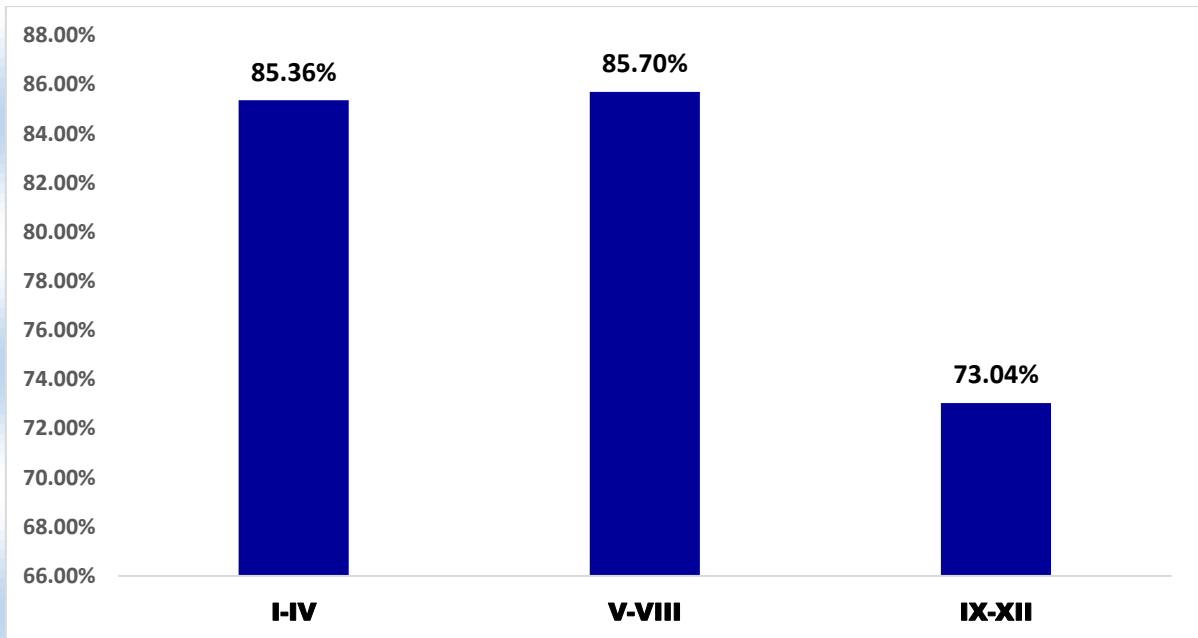

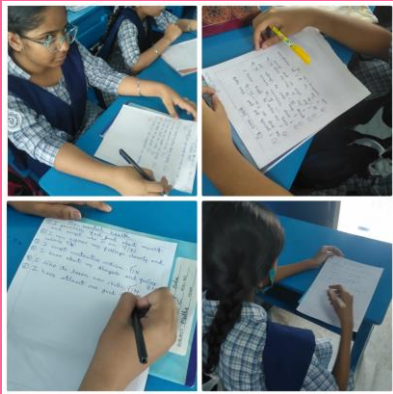
The Magazine/Journal 'The Magic Pot' was distributed among the students of classes I-III.


