


It is safe to say that, when schools reopen, what has been learned from this experience should be used to effect positive change in the approach to improve lives

To ensure a happy and healthy life for all, a webinar was organized on the occasion of the virtual launch of the Health Education Curriculum. Mr Anurag Tripathi, Dr Muffazal Lakdawala and Mr Dilip Thakore graced the occasion with their presence. Our Principal ma'am, teachers, parents and students were invited to attend the launch ceremony.






Adieu Adieu!!






