KMSSS has been very fortunate to have supportive Management, Teachers, Parents and Students through the whole process and as an Institution we are **GROWING through the change.**

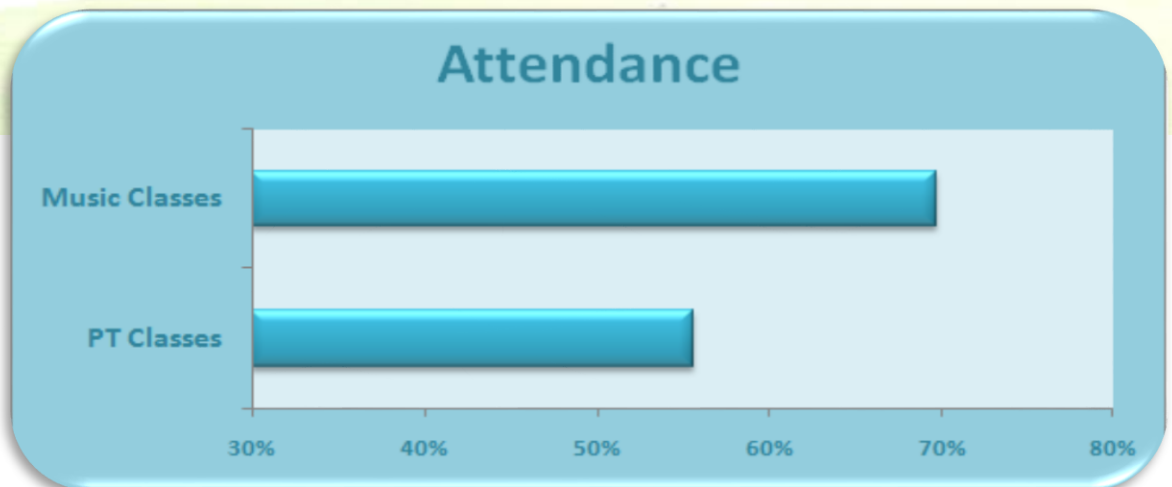
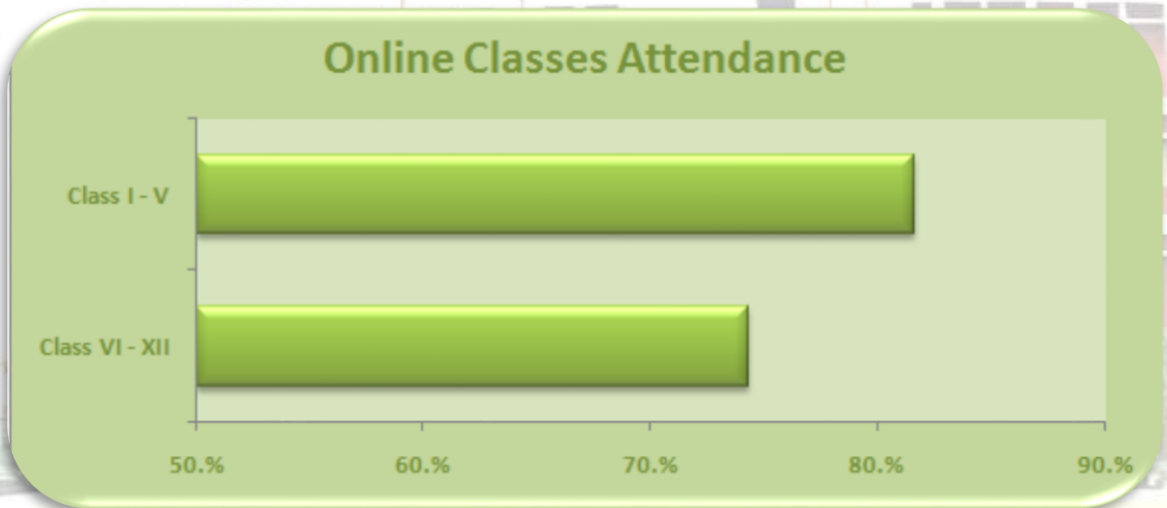
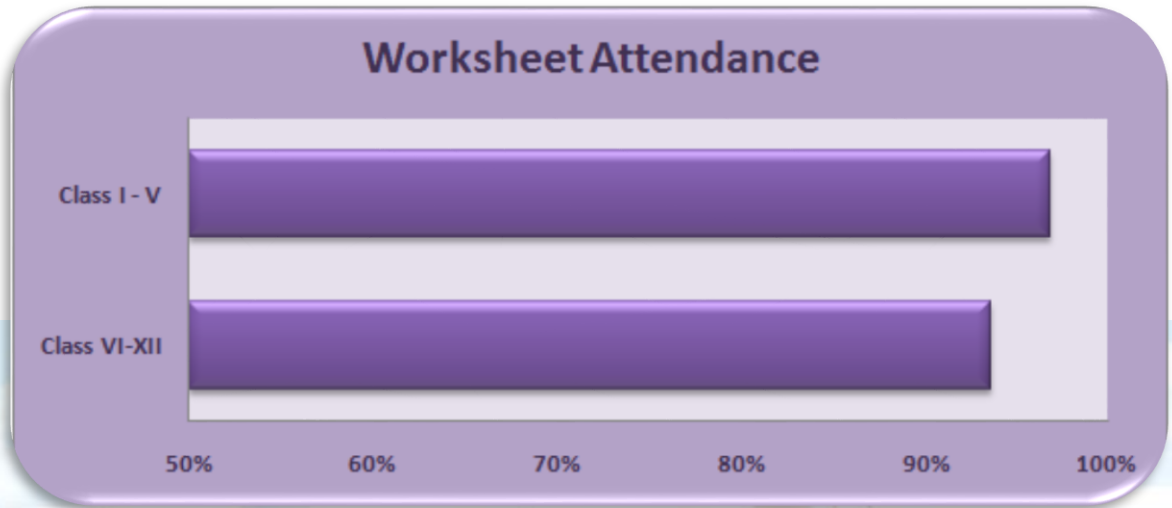
