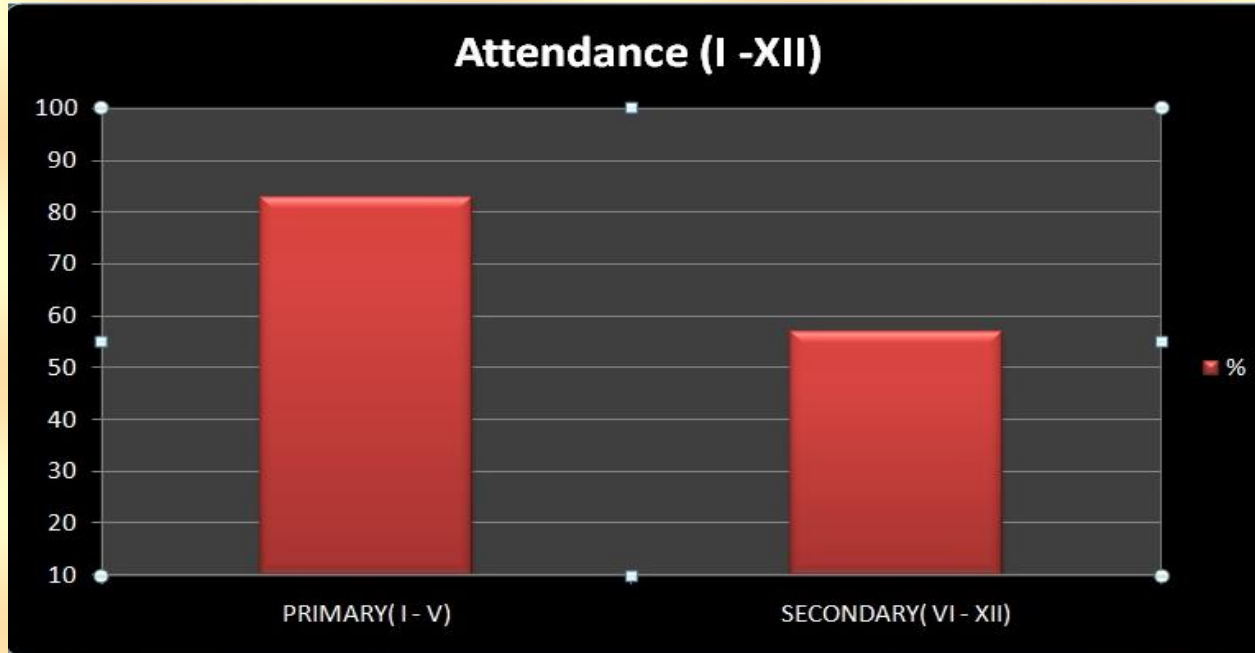

One possible silver lining to emerge from this situation could be that a new relationship with technology could lead to some positive outcomes.

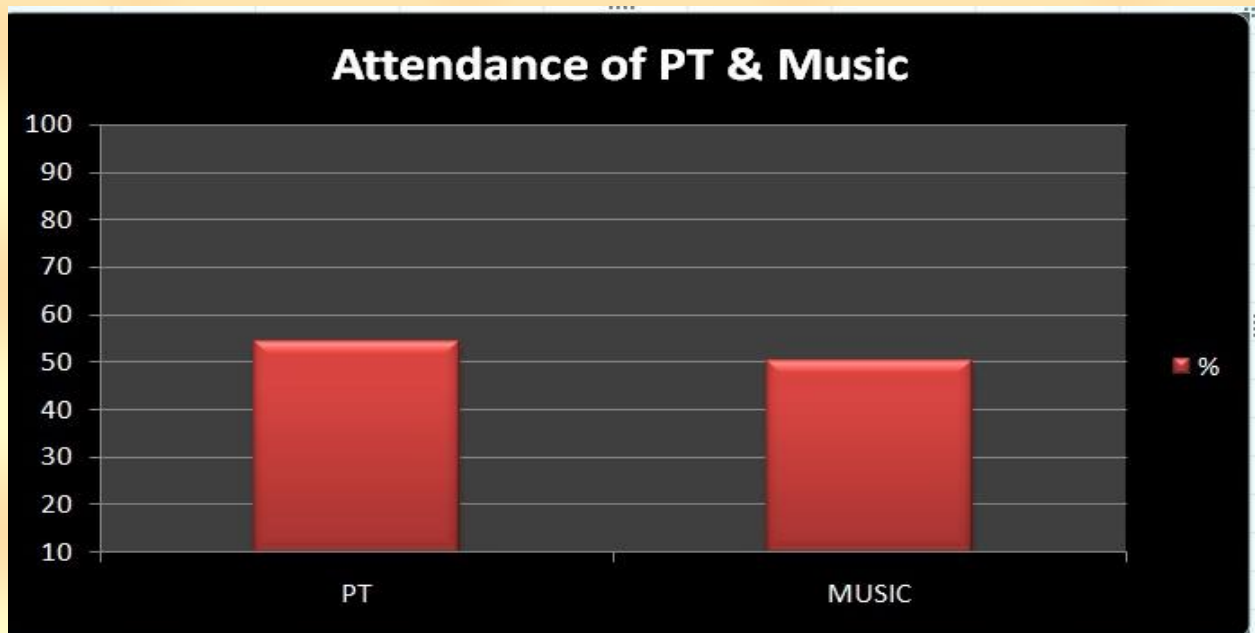
