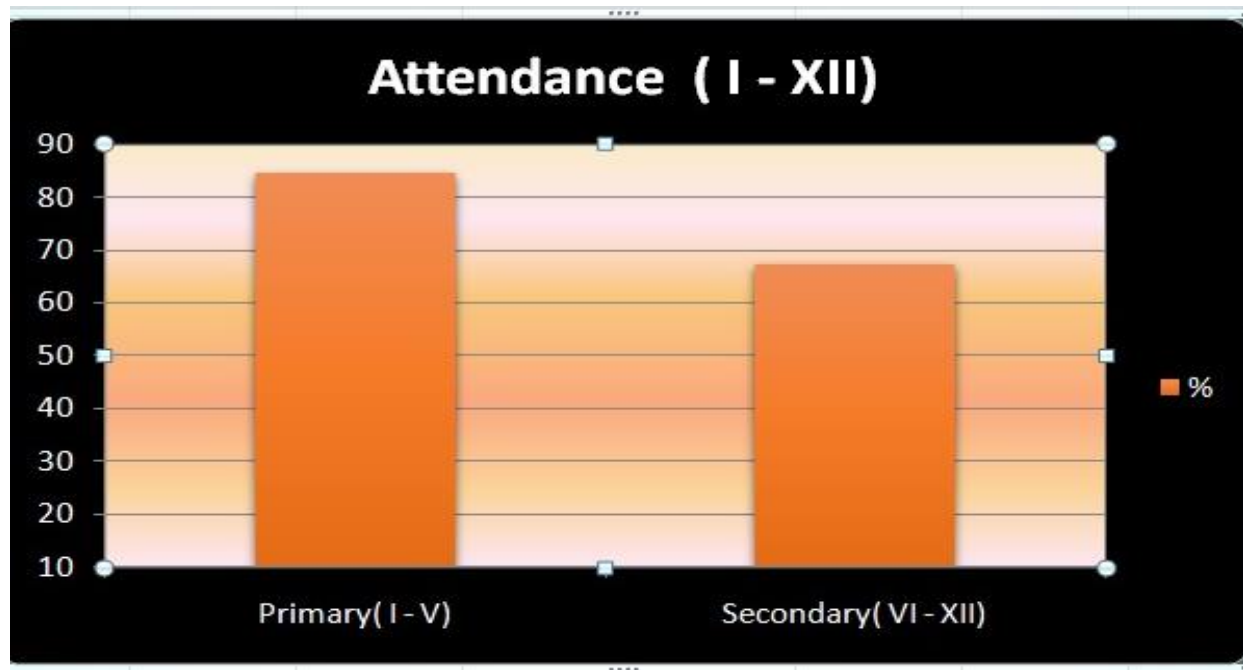
A positive attitude lets you to relax, remember, focus and absorb information as you learn and also makes you ready to welcome new experiences and recognize many different kinds of learning opportunities.

When you can see opportunities, hope increases!

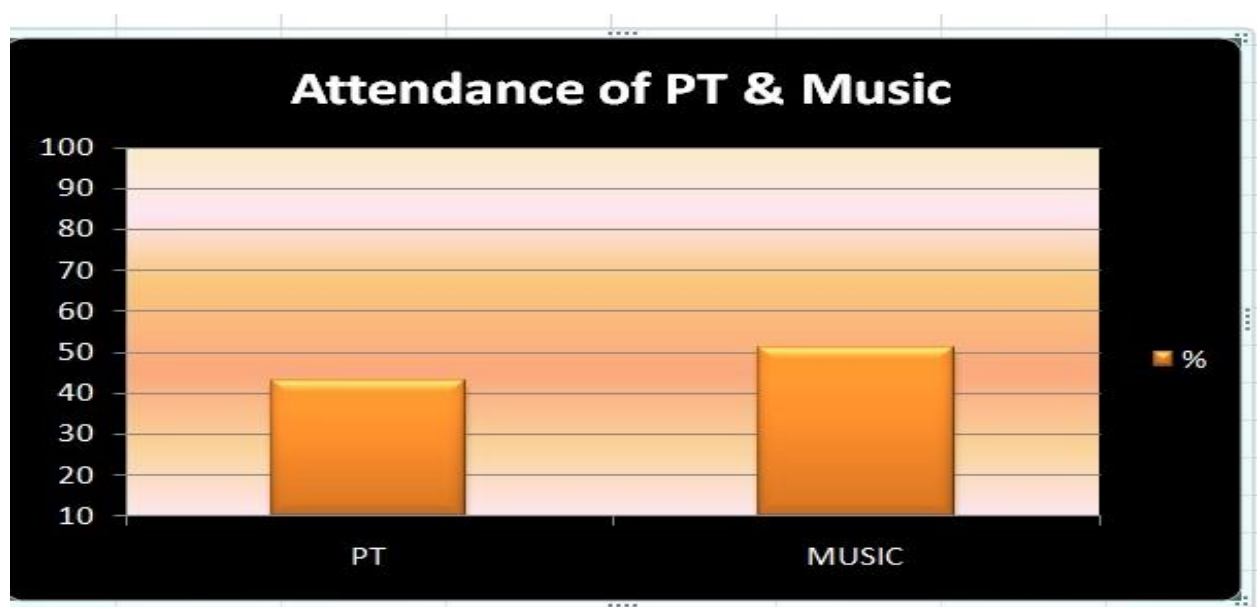

Life skills Programme for Students

A series of life skills programmes were conducted throughout the month for the students of classes I-IX

For classes I- III the topic was ' **Waiting for Turn**'. Listening to the story on turn taking, the students shared their thought and feelings depicting the fact that they could understand and relate with the main idea of the story. 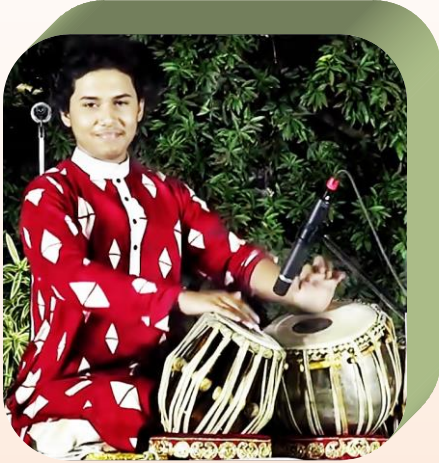
