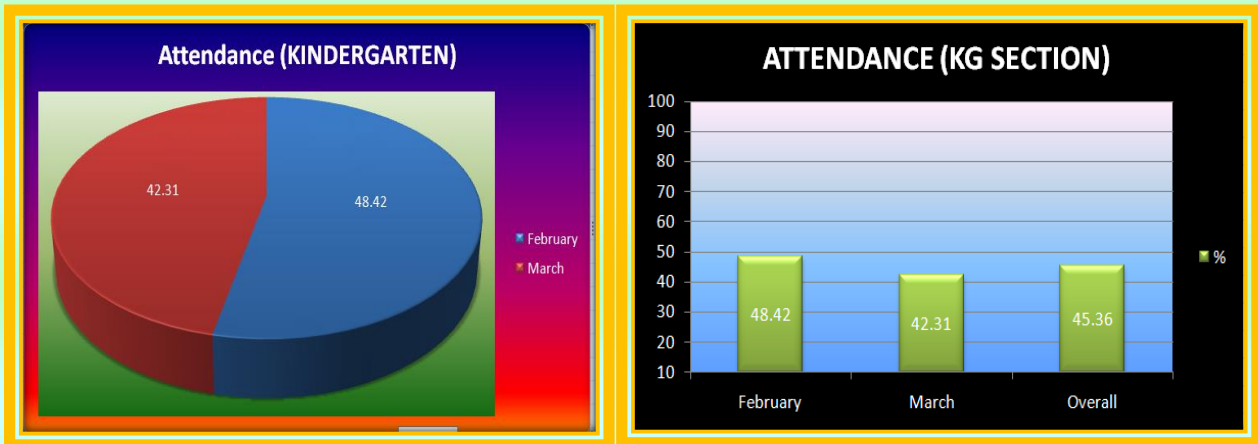
Parents will be better connected to, and involved with, their child's education with certainty, detail, and confidence.

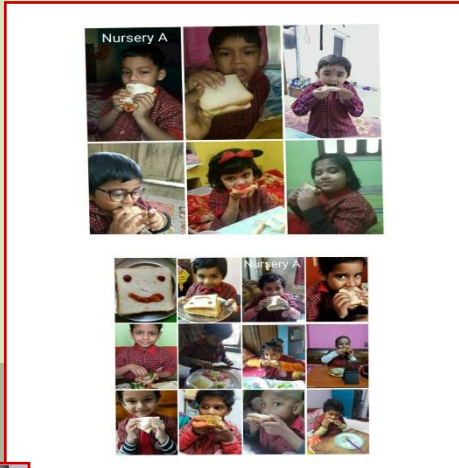

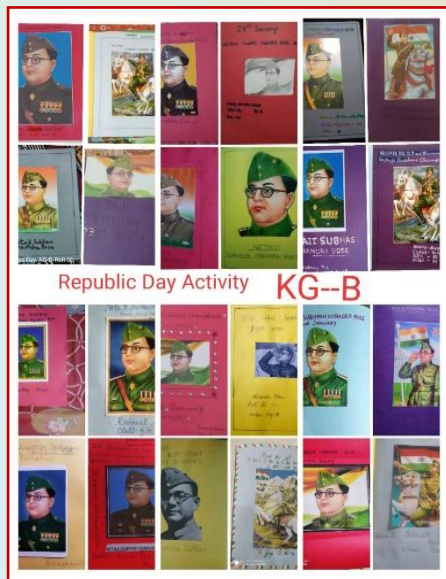

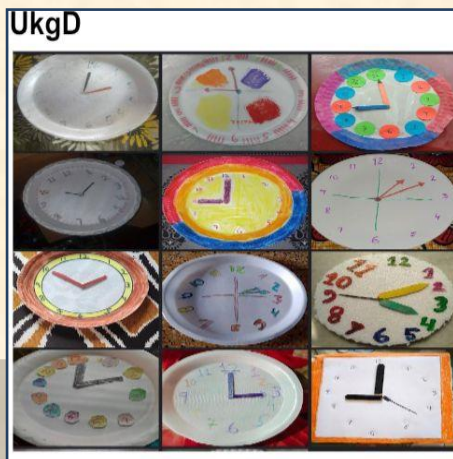
