Speech on Bhagat Singh Ji by the tiny tots was conducted in the Morning Assembly.

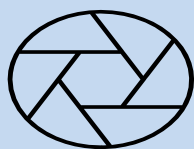
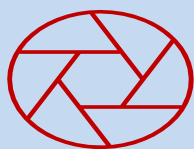
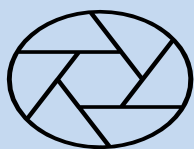
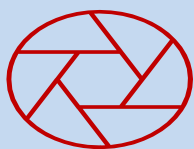
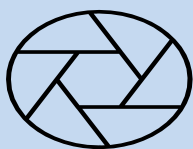
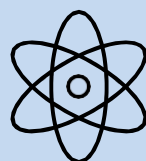
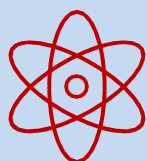
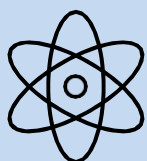
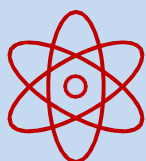
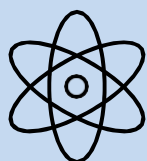
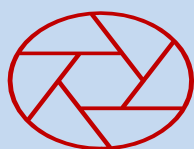
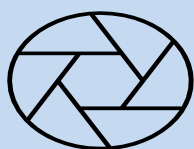
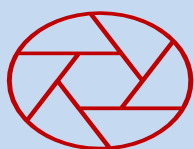
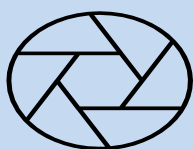
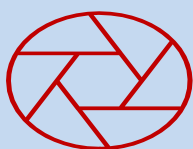
