In today's multidisciplinary world, team building is crucial for success. As a student who wants to reach success, need to make sure that they are aware of the importance of teamwork.

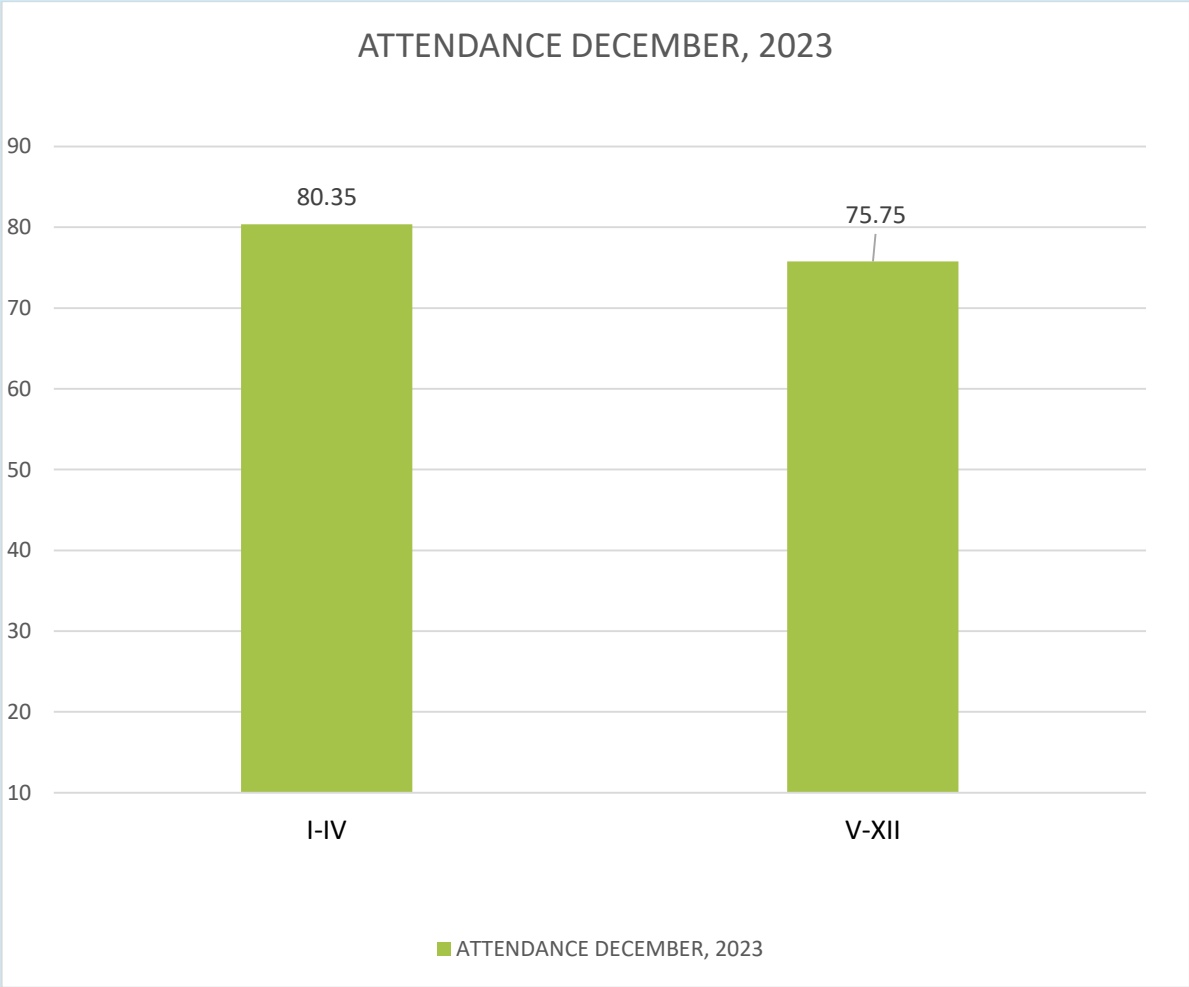

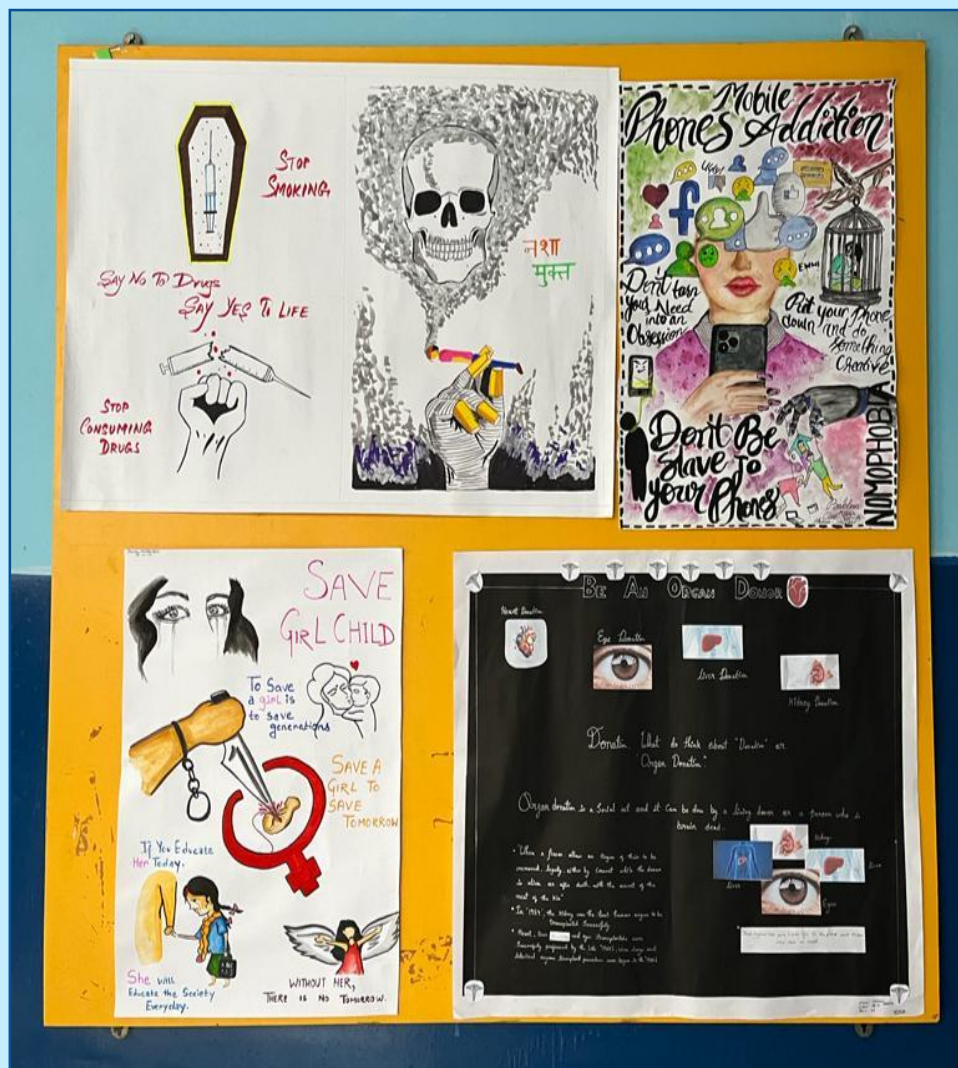

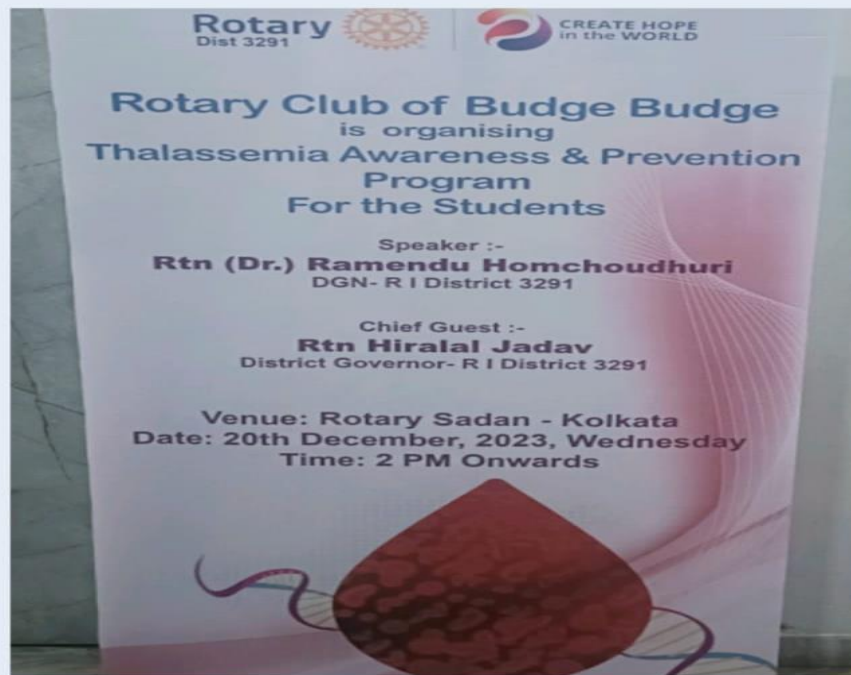

It is a genetic disorder of blood having less haemoglobin which is found in the children just after their birth after 6 months. This is the only genetic disease that is 99% incurable but 100% preventable. We can prevent this by making a big change from "Horoscope to microscope". If marriage will be between two carrier parents there will be a 25% chance of a baby being thalassaemic. The only thing we can do is having a blood test once in life to detect a carrier, The HPLC test.
