"There is a popular notion rather I would say a misconception that values are "better caught than taught". At Khalsa, attempts are made so that values are both caught and taught.

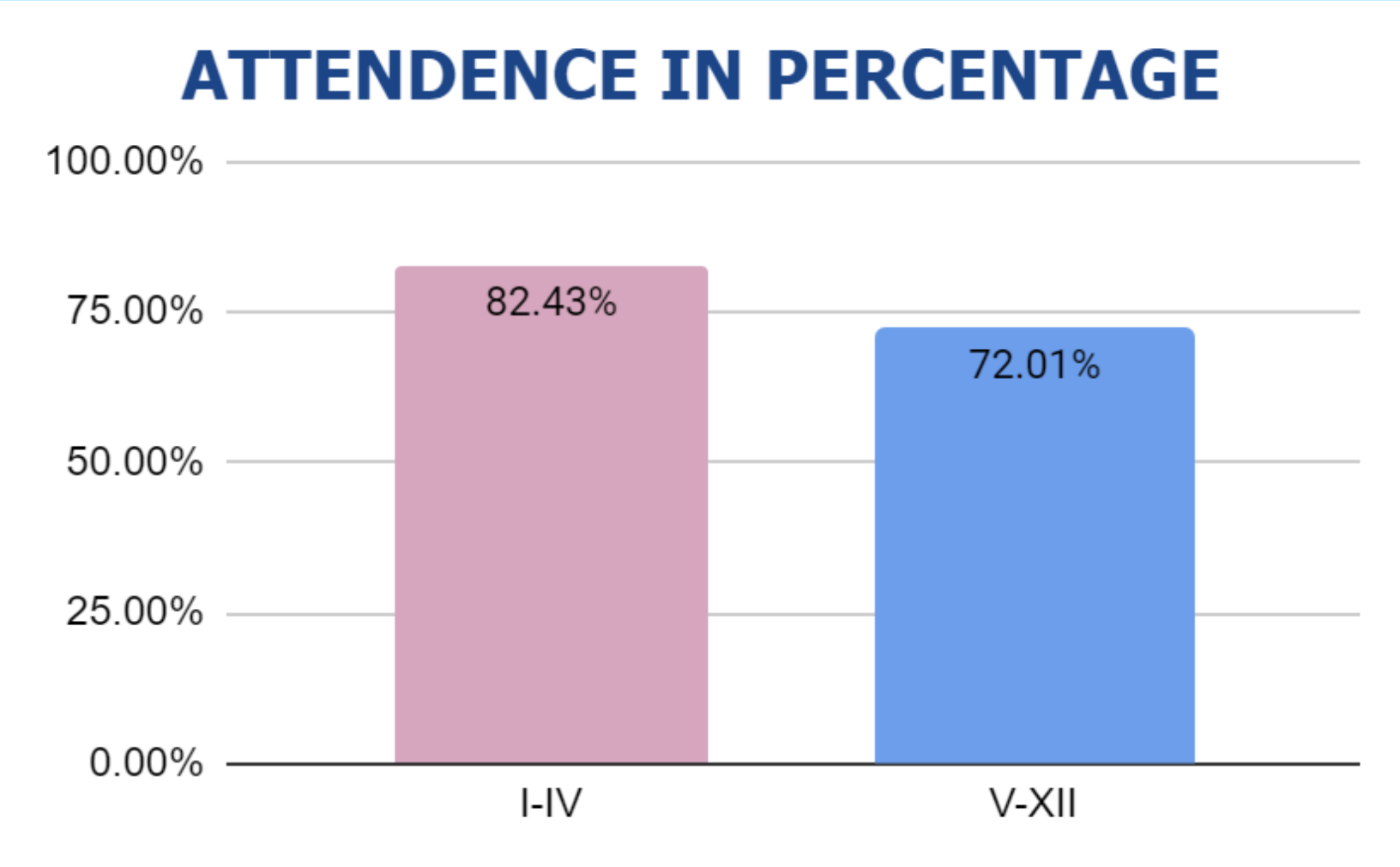
Mere desire or aspiration to progress in life is not enough; success should be based on values. So that the students may emerge as good leaders in their chosen fields.

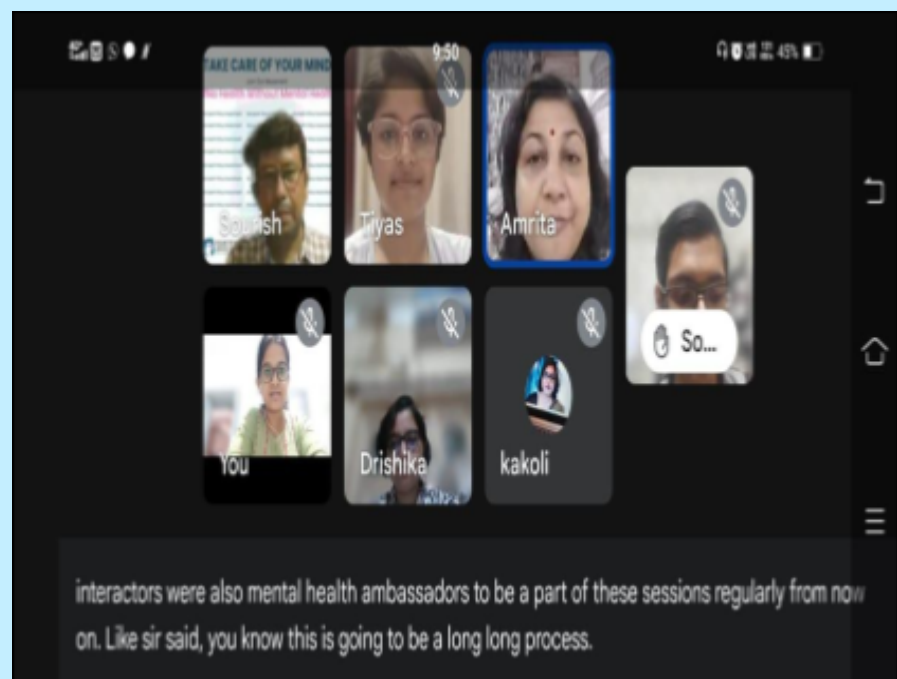


Dental camp was organized by Guru Nanak Dental College for the students of Class X. They received their Dental Health Card free of cost, after their dental check-up by the dentists.

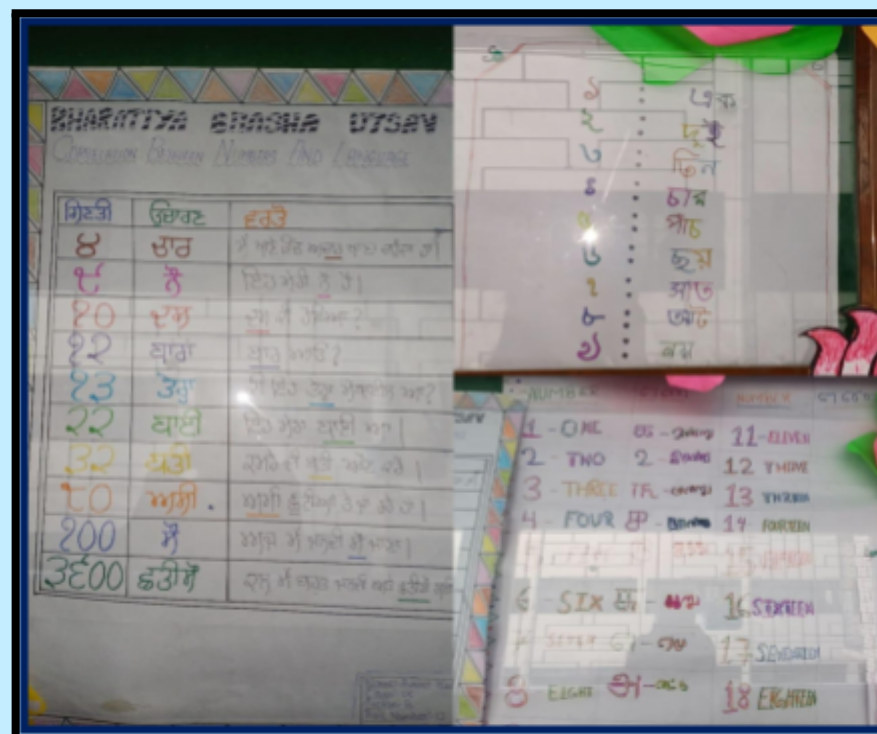
