May the coming year bring along new hopes and new opportunities.... May you learn from your past mistakes and accomplish your targets for the future with your strength and dedication....

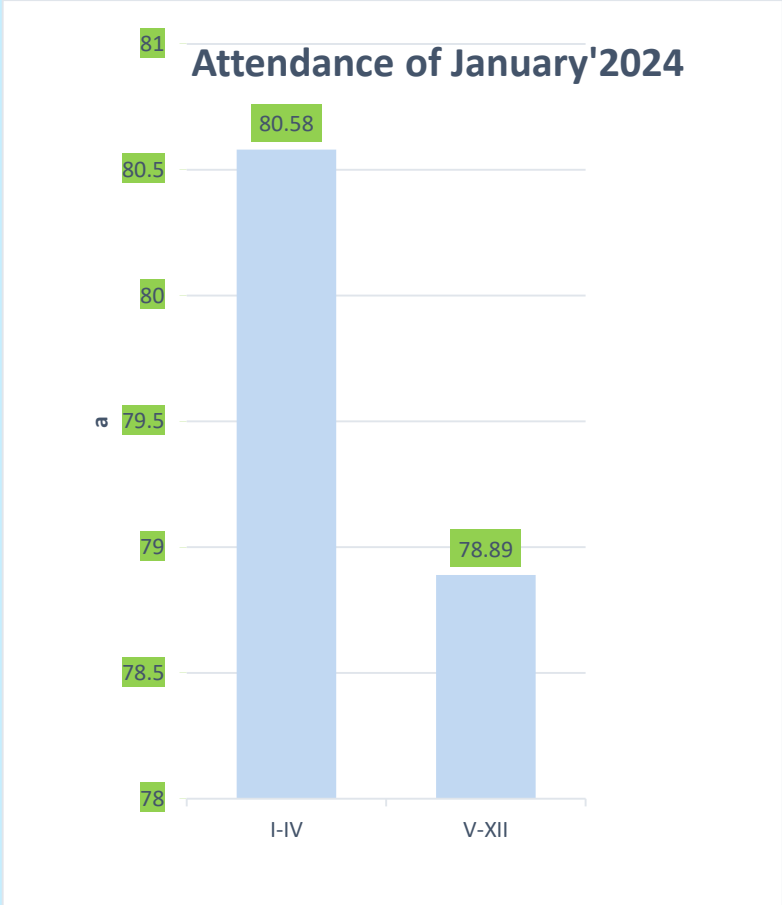

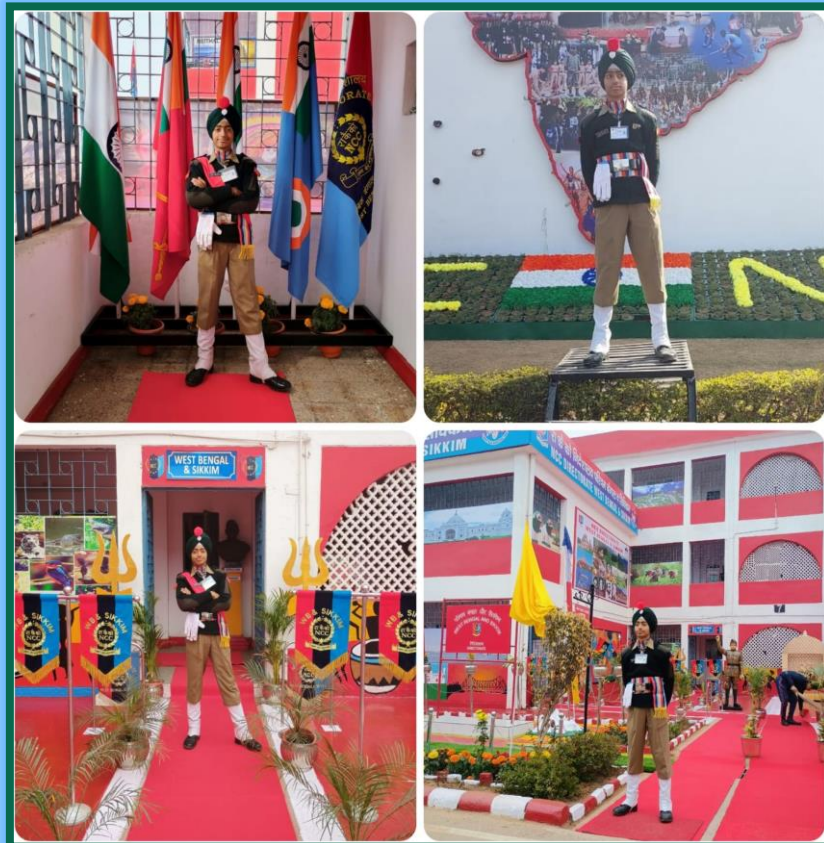

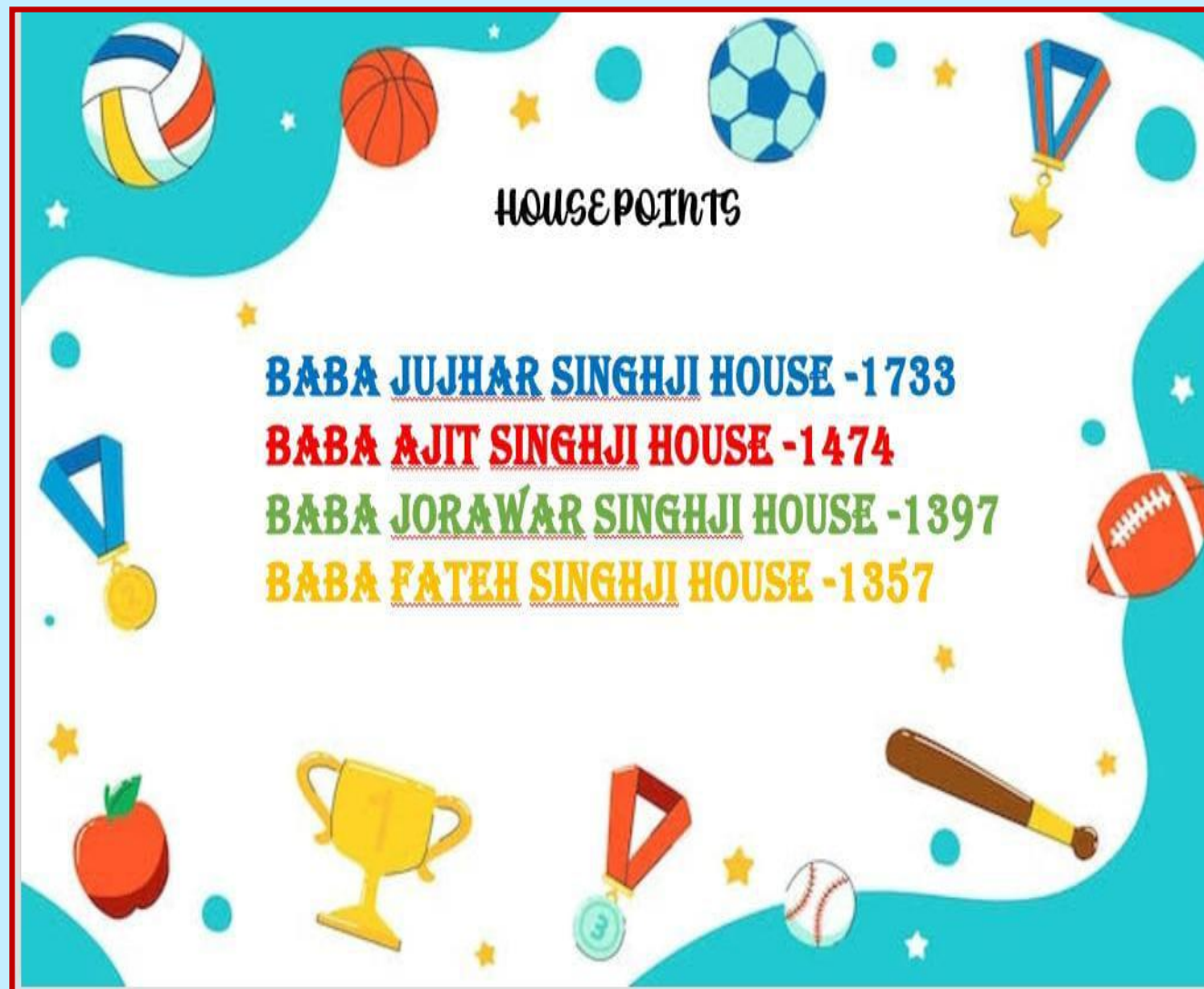


ACTIVITIES DONE IN THE LIBRARY
