November, the month of celebrations.

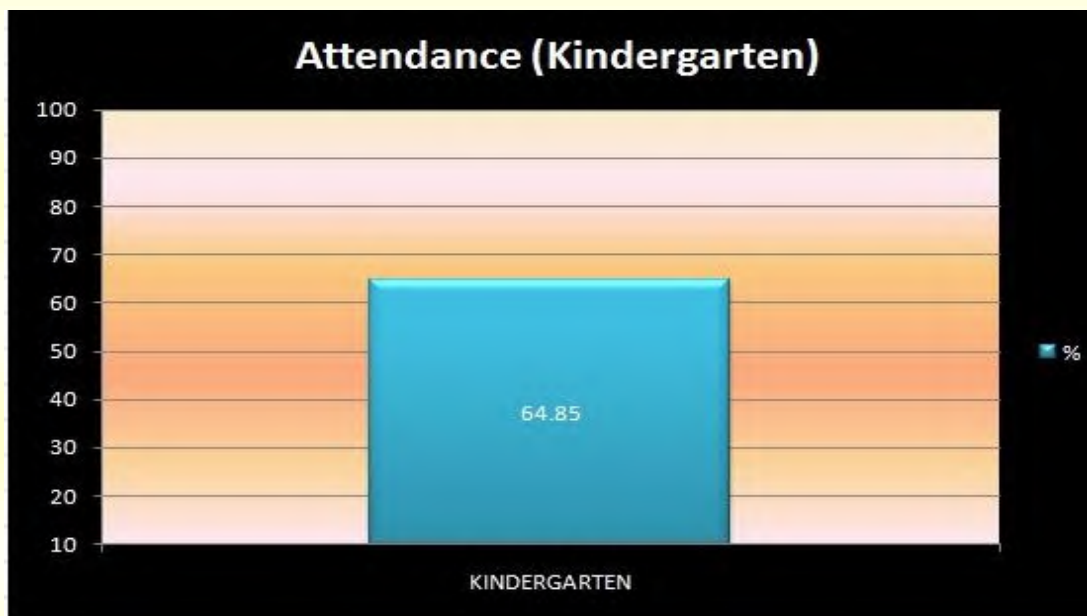
